

# QUEEN OF THE PARK FREQUENTYL ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHERE WILL THE QUEEN OF THE PARK GAMES BE PLAYED?

The Queen of The Park Games will be at Michael A. Carroll Stadium and the grass field located behind the scoreboard on the east side of the stadium. All Queen of the Park participants and spectators must access the stadium through **Gate C** (off New York St and Barnhill Dr) and then walk through the stadium to get to the grass fields.

### WHAT TIME DO QUEEN OF THE PARK GAMES START?

The Queen of the Park Games will begin on a central horn at 1:00pm EST. All teams are encouraged to arrive to the playing fields by 12:30pm EST.

### **HOW IS QUEEN OF THE PARK PLAYED?**

Except for the winner of the games played on the top field, if your team wins you move up to the next field, if your team loses, you move down to the previous field.

### WHERE CAN QUEEN OF THE PARK TEAMS AND SPECTATORS PARK?

All event participants should park in the Vermont St Parking Garage (off New York St and Barnhill Dr) and then will enter the stadium through Gate C. GPS Directions: 1004 W Vermont St, Indianapolis, 46202. Parking fees will apply upon exiting.

# WHERE CAN QUEEN OF THE PARK PARTICIPANTS PICK UP THEIR GAME TICKETS?

All Queen of the Park teams receive entry to all 12 international games being played on Friday and Saturday at Carroll Stadium. Please see below pick up locations for each day.

**Friday's Games:** Players and coaches should go to Will Call (at Gate C) and provide their first and last name for entry and a wristband for re-entry purposes.

**Saturday's Games:** For any players that are also signed up for the Skills Clinic, they will receive their ticket (wristband) for Saturday's games at Check-in. For any players not signed up for the Skills Clinic, they will receive at the Queen of the Park games when provided their pinnie.



# DO PARENTS/FAMILIES NEED TO PURCHASE TICKETS TO WATCH THE QUEEN OF THE PARK GAMES?

Parents/families **do not** have to purchase tickets to watch the Skills Clinics or Queen of the Park games, **however**, if parents/families are also planning to attend any of the international games on Saturday at the conclusion of Queen of the Park, it is encouraged they <u>pre-purchase their discounted tickets</u>. If they leave the venue and return, if they do not have a ticket, they will have to pay for one at the walk-up ticket price.

### WILL THERE BE SPECTATOR SEATING AT QUEEN OF THE PARK?

There will not be seating/bleachers provided at the playing fields. Spectators can bring in their own chairs, but if staying for the international games, will have to return the chairs to their vehicle.

#### **CAN WE BRING IN FOOD OR DRINKS?**

**No**. Outside food and drinks are not permitted in the Stadium. There will be hydration stations for the teams at the playing fields; spectators can go to concessions which opens at 12:00pm EST.

### WHAT OTHER OPPORTUNITIES ARE AVAILABLE FOR MY TEAM?

Prior to the Queen of the Park Games there will be the **Skills Clinic presented by Gait Lacrosse** from 9:00am – 12:00pm EST. All Queen of the Park players, once they've added themselves to their team, can add-on the Skills Clinic free of charge.

For the High School teams, we are offering a free mentorship and educational workshop for young women, aged 16-22.

### AS A COACH, AM I ABLE TO ATTEND THE SKILLS CLINIC?

Yes. Queen of the Park Coaches can watch the Skills Clinics too.
